
Hispanic American Business Overview

In FY2011, MBDA assisted Hispanic American-owned businesses with gaining access to \$979 million in contracts and capital. This represents a 17 percent increase over FY2010 levels. During the 3-year period of the Obama Administration, MBDA assisted 5,192 Hispanic Americanowned businesses in obtaining \$3.5 billion in contracts and capital—an outstanding 92 percent increase over the prior 3-year period.

With an average contract size of \$2.4 million for Hispanic Americanowned businesses, MBDA has worked hard to help these firms grow.

businesses.


